The legend has it this place was once surrounded by fire so that no one could go out or in of the fortress.
2. Chitrlekha Udyan: It was established in the year 1904, also known as Cole Park, is one of the most peaceful attractions in Tezpur. The park is named after Chitrlekha – a famous person in Anirudha and Usha mythological love story. It is known for its scenic beauty and a beautiful lake where one can indulge in a boating experience.
